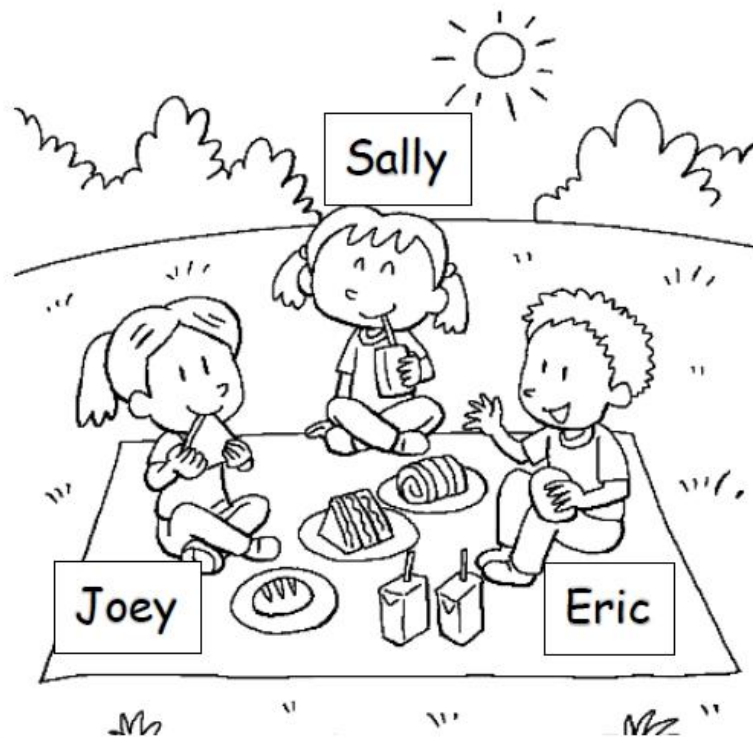

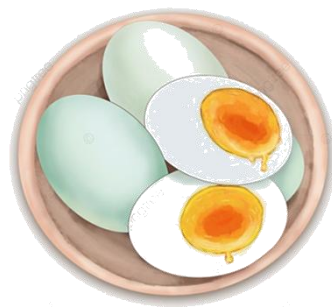

In the end, Alice said sorry to the zookeeper. The zookeeper forgave her. What a bad day!



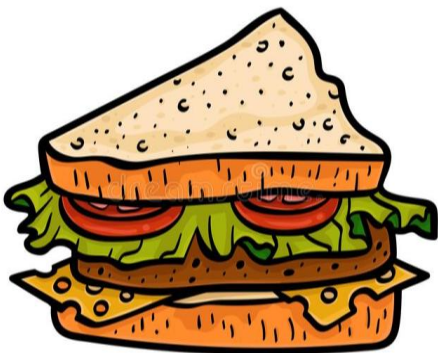

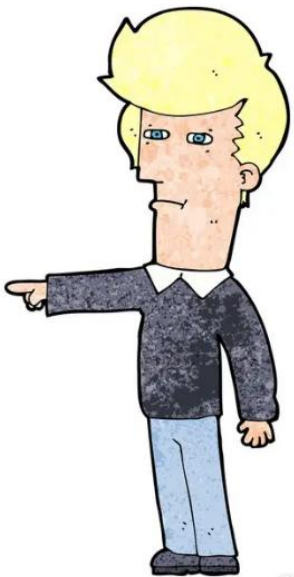

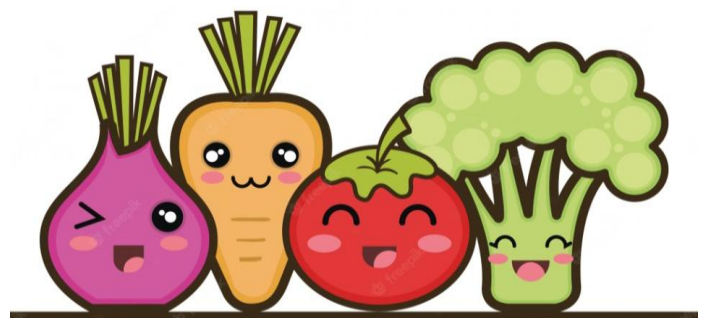

We had different ideas so we argued with each other. Emma shouted at me loudly and I was very angry. I pushed Emma onto the ground and she was hurt. She began to cry.

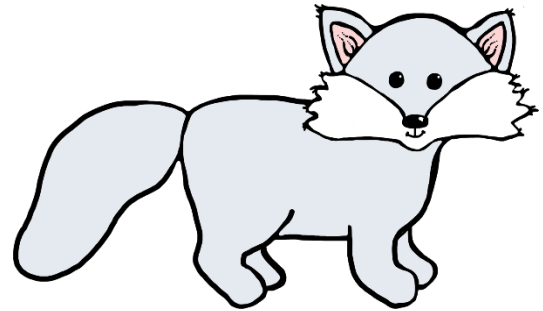

# Arctic Fox

## Appearance

They have bushy white long tails, curled black ears and small black noses. Although they seem pure white, their skin is dark under their white coats.

## Diet and Habitat

Arctic foxes like eating small animals such as fish and seabirds. Arctic foxes are found in the Arctic regions of the Northern Hemisphere. Their round compact bodies minimize areas exposed to the cold air.

## Size

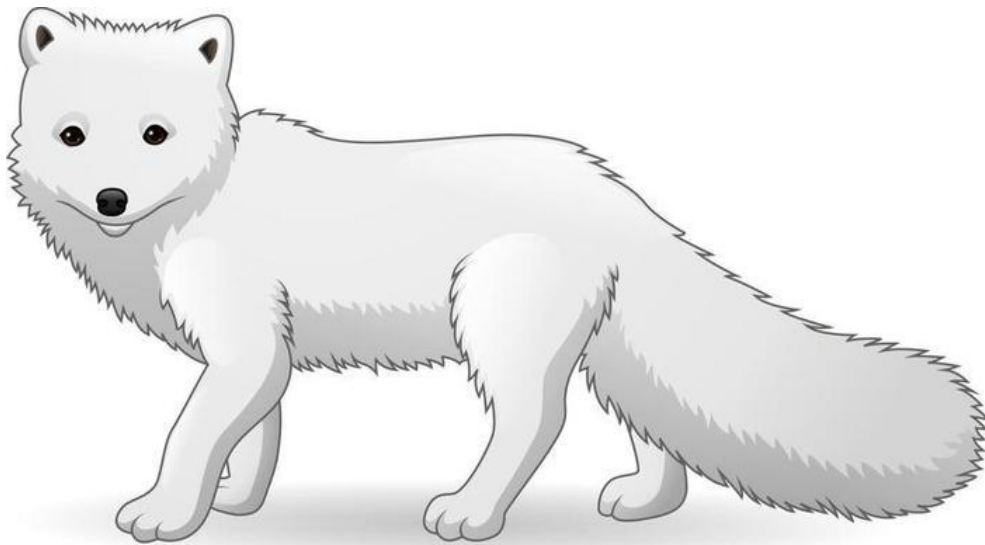
Adult Arctic foxes can grow up to 25-30cm in height. Female Arctic foxes can grow up to 41-55cm in length whilst Male Arctic foxes can grow up to 46-68cm in length.



## Other interesting facts

There are eight recognized subspecies of Arctic foxes. Arctic fox fur changes seasonally. In the winter, they sport fluffy white coats that blend into the snow; in the summer they shed these coats for brownish or grayish, shorter fur that helps them camouflage into bare rocks and dirt.

They can have two litters in a season and will emerge from the den at about four weeks old, staying with the male and learning to hunt.



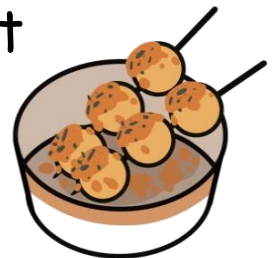
# A Letter to Yuna

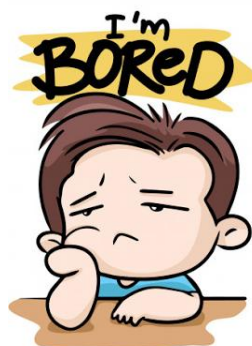

One day, I woke up in a strange place in the afternoon. I opened the windows and I saw some old

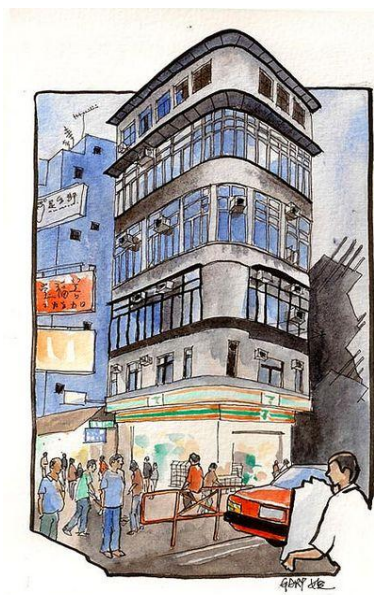
Hong Kong tenement buildings. I felt shocked. My hands covered my mouth.

On the street, I could see some people carrying the old baskets. I could hear

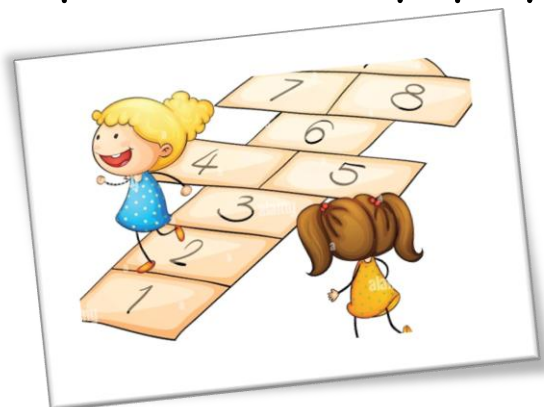
a man singing and playing the guitar. I could also smell the geese sold by the

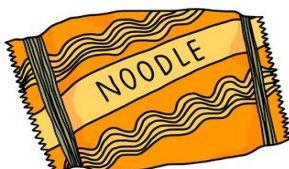
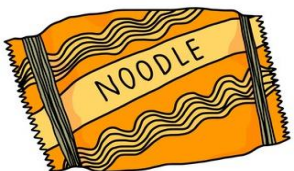

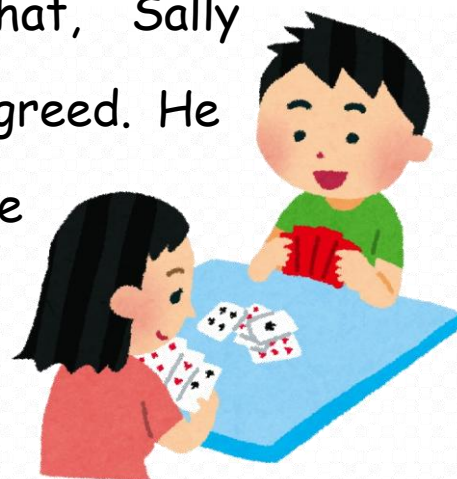
noodles either.' They couldn't cook noodles by

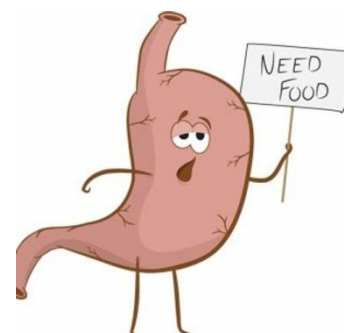

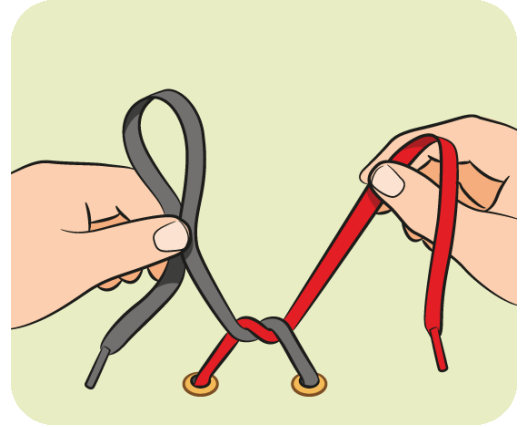

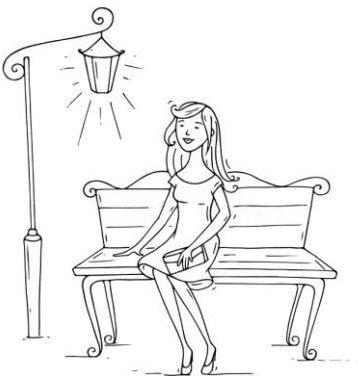

Visiting the elderly's home was a meaningful experience. I will always keep this experience in my mind.

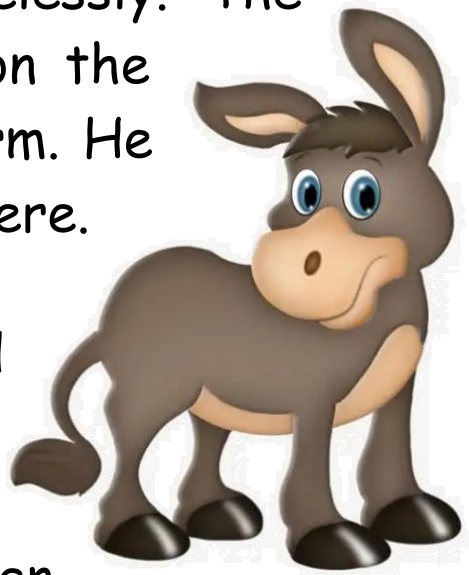




# The Donkey in the Lion's Skin

# A fight between good and evil

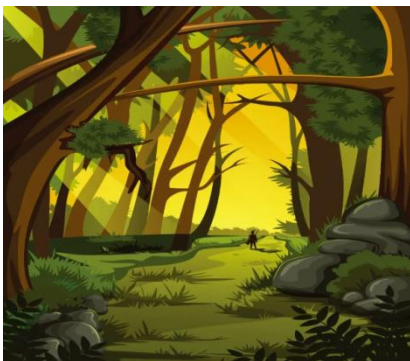

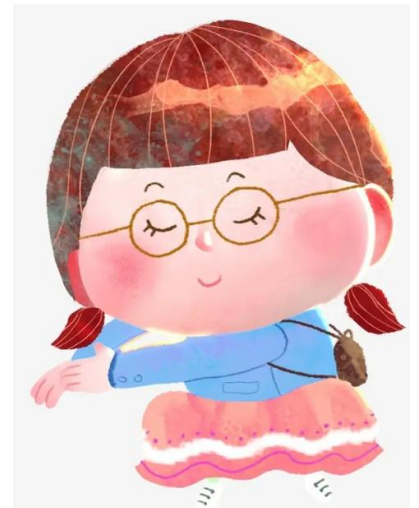




# In good shape

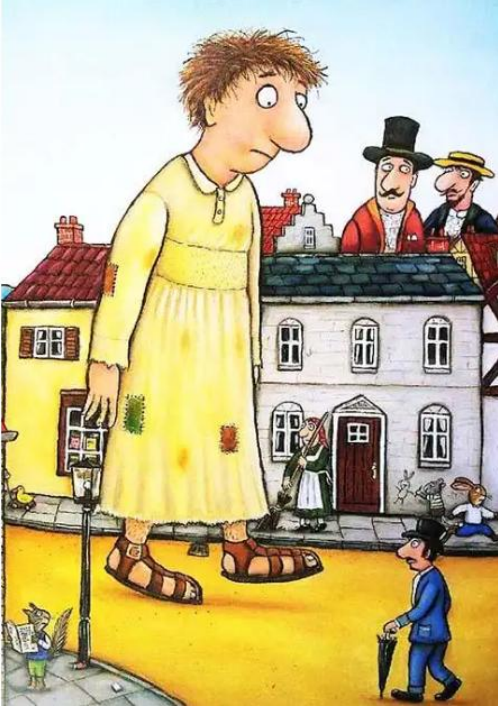

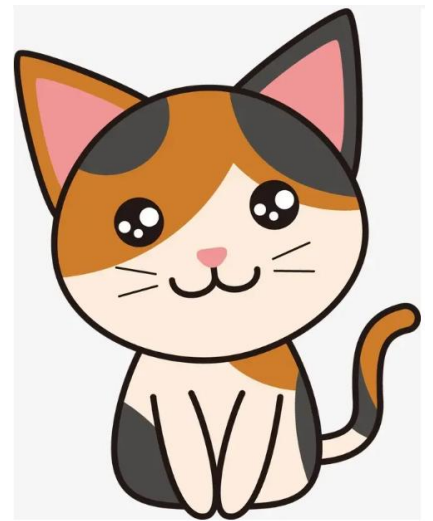

The next day, Billy took out the map and studied carefully. He marked his destination and planned his route. He was ready to set off. He went to the faraway island by boat.

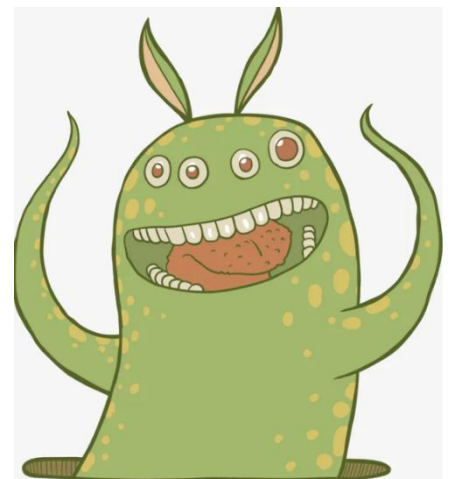
