His shorts are purple.

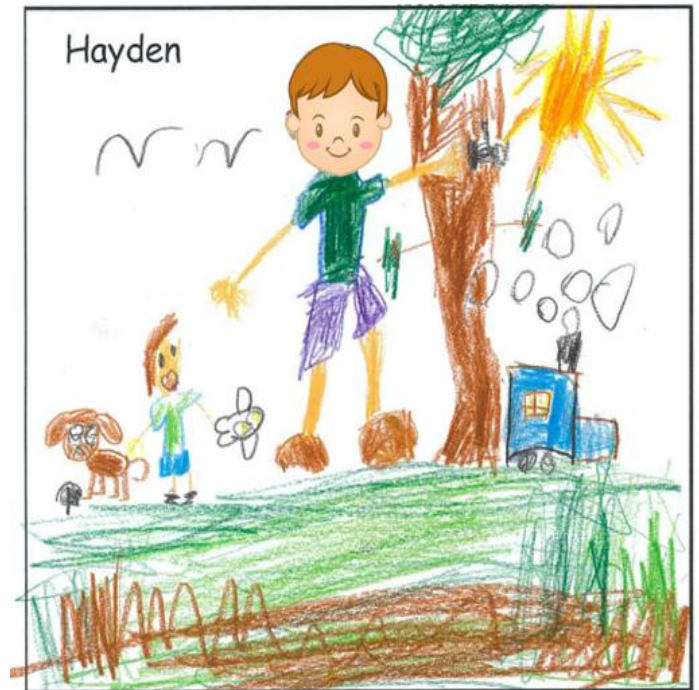
He has big eyes and a big nose.

Two years ago, Jack and his mum were in their mansion. Jack was eating plenty of junk

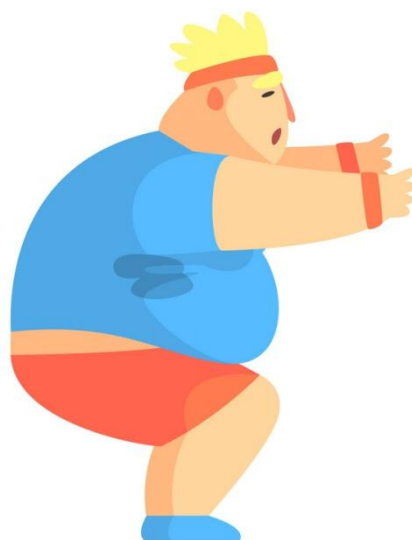
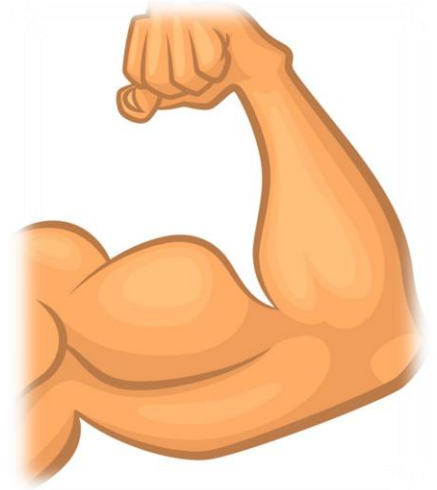


food but he didn't eat any vegetables. Jack's mum was worried about his physical health.

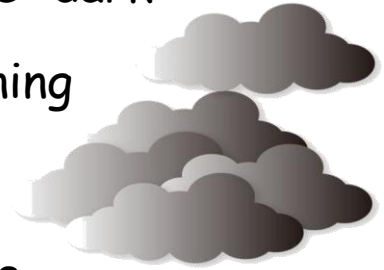
'Today is a happy day. I helped the zookeeper find the missing animals,' the boy said joyfully.

One day, Jack and his mum sat on the sofa. Mum pointed at the calendar and said, 'Jack, your birthday is coming. I'll make a cake for you.'

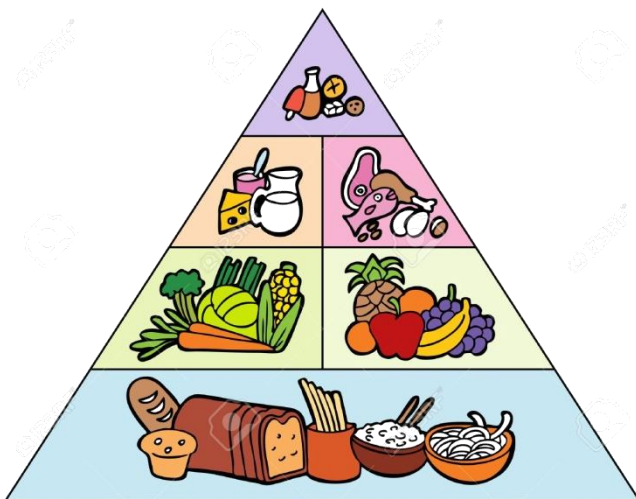
Jack thought that it would be a delicious chocolate cake. He looked forward to eating the birthday cake.

Mrs Wong put some sandwiches she had made in the lunch box. Mr Wong checked the weather forecast.

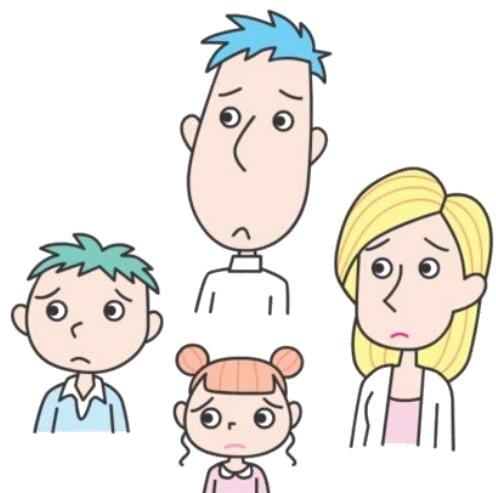


May and Lily packed their swimming suits and a kite. Mr Wong asked Mrs Wong to put an umbrella in the backpack and May fed the cat before they left.

In the end the Wong family went home. They were very disappointed. It was an unlucky day for them.





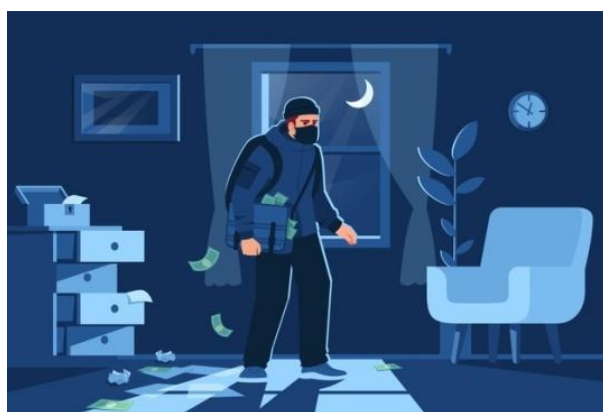
# A Theft

Everyone can be a good person and do good things. Kindness is a virtue!

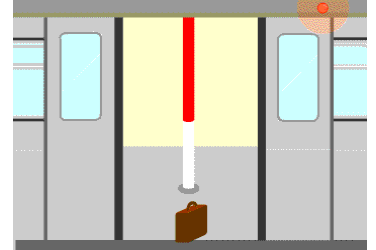




## Good People Good Deeds: Let's make the world a better place
